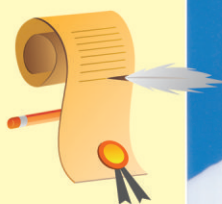
Message

Our Father Founder, Very Rev. Msgr. Joseph K.W. Thomas Kandathil, a priest of the Archdiocese of Ernakulam - Angamaly, known as Kerala Damien, offered his life in intense prayer and deep recollection to love and serve the poor and the afflicted. He shared the missionary dimension of Franciscan life, to evangelize and proclaim the Good News. As we have inherited from our Father Founder we "The Assisi Sisters of Mary Immaculate", continue this loving service to the sick, suffering and the rejected in the society especially the leprosy stricken brethren, differently abled children and HIV affected people.

'KERALA DAMIEN' TO THE PRIVILEGE OF SERVANT OF GOD IN THE CHURCH



Very Rev Msgr. Joseph K. W. Thomas Kandathil is the founder of the Greengarden institutions and the congregation of the 'Assisi Sisters of Mary Immaculate'. Came to be known as '**Kerala Damien**' dedicated his life to the service of lepers. God made him a tool to change the complexion of Anatharaveli. He turned the graveyard into green gardens. God blessed him with the privilege of 'The Servant of God' so that the Glory of God would reach unto the ends of the world.

The declaration of the Servant of God held at Greengardens, Cherthala on 6th Feb 2020. Sister General welcomed all the dignitaries. Cardinal Mar. George Alencherry inaugurated the function and spoke earnestly about the heroic life of our Father Founder. Rev. Dr. Jose Pollayil read the vatican's Non Objection Decree dated 24. 10. 2019 to declare Msgr. Joseph Kandathil a Servant of God. Mar. Antony Kariyil, Arch Bishop of Ernakulam Angamaly expressed his experience and loving care of Father Founder and founding sisters to him and his family and he reminded the hardships taken by our Father Founder for the development of Mathilakam. Mar. James Raphael Anaparambil shared his experience with our Founder, while he was a young priest. Bishop Emeritus Mar. Stephen Athipposhiyil was also present in the ceremony. About 400 people, including our provincials, sisters, priests, sisters from other congregation, representatives from the parish and members of Kandathil family participated in the ceremony.



CARING LOVE OF OUR FATHER FOUNDER

At the Age of twelve, I joined the ASMI congregation, that cared for the poor and lepers. From that time on, I experienced our Father Founder's love and care untill his death. For me he was a father and mother. In 1952, I was

in-charge of laboratory of S. H. Hospital, there were no trained sisters except Sr. Celene, who was the in-charge of pharmacy of the hospital at Cherthala. I could not have lunch in time, because of my busy work in the laboratory. So I used to take lunch at 3 pm. One day, as I was doing my duty in the lab, our Father Founder came and stood behind me in the laboratory. When I got up to greet him, he asked me. Did you have lunch? No, I replied. He told me to go and eat. I tried to close the door of the laboratory but he didnot allow and waited there in front of the lab untill I returned to the lab after lunch. When I reached the lab, he smiled at me as loving, caring and protecting mother and gave me a warning that now you are quiet young. If you do not lake care of your health, you would become sick. I experienced his loving care many times in my life. He helped me to grow even when I was in Rome for my higher studies by writting letters with inspiring messages.

MAGNANIMOUS SERVICE OF 30 YEARS IN GERMANY

St. Francis region in Germany celebrated its 30 years of Jubilee as a thanks giving to God who guided us all throughout these years. On 14th October 1989, sisters Juliet, Rosilin, Suso, Selvi, Telma, Arpitha Mercitta, Lissia and Trinitha with Provincial Sr. Michael and councillor Sr. Florence came to Germany and started our mission. Our sisters stayed with Franciscan sisters in their mother house for the first few



months. In the initial stages we were helped out by the Franciscan sisters. In the year 1990 one of the Franciscan sisters, Sr. Edelgardies together with Sr. Rosilin took up the responsibility of one of the old age homes, which was running under the Caritas organisation of the Bamberg Diocese. Later in the year 1993 Sr. Juliet with sisters Telma and Trinitha took up the responsibility from Sr. Edelgardies, of the old age home at Egerburg.

30 of our sisters are now doing the selfless service in 6 communities under 3 Dioceses. Two communities take up the responsibilities of other four houses, including the administration. Sisters joyfully offer their time and health for the good of the people who are entrusted to our care. We try to live out our charism through our activities and as a model religious for others, to whom we come in contact with. The Caritas organisation which entrusted us their two old age homes used to appreciate us saying that we run these two houses in German style.

30th Jubilee celebration was an opportunity to thank God for all His care and support. We celebrated the Jubilee in our regional house at Eggolsheim together with many of the priests from near by communities and our benefactors.

During the Eucharistic celebration we prayed in a special way for our regional superior Sr. Juliet, councillors Sr. Telma and Trinitha and for the sisters Selvi, Lissia, Mercitta who accepted the will of God and started the service in Germany 30 years back.



They never became tired in sufferings and hardships which they had to face at the initial stages, instead they became a guiding lamp for all by holding the sisters together. The “Muthuchippi” that they offered during the Eucharistic celebration symbolised the efforts and struggles that they had undertaken in the last 30 years, to be a precious pearl in the hands of God.

We also remembered and prayed for the sisters, who offers their services in Germany as well as in India and Africa. We believe that our existence here is a great help for the people to experience the compassionate love of our Heavenly Father. “We are trying to hold the good things which we received as a gift from God”. Cherishing the word of our beloved Sr. Juliet “we go forward to spread the kingdom of God”.

AFRICAN MISSION

He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to all creation.” (mk. 16:15)

Holding these words so close to our heart we started our African Mission. We the Assisi Sisters of Mary Immaculate arrived in Africa with 5 sisters in 2003 to preach the good news to the people in Africa. Sisters make use of their time and talents to raise worthy children and nurture healthy people. They share their time with the people in singing, eating and dancing as part of inculturation. The windows of knowledge are opened to them with the intention of making them superior citizens for the better tomorrow. They are educated through regular education. A hospital was established to improve health in the society.

Our sisters are eagerly participating in parish activities to foster them to lead a better christian life. We thank God for helping us to continue our mission,

enjoying the love of Christ. As we are completing the 17th year of our mission in Africa, God has blessed us in many ways. Now we have 12 sisters, who all have joyfully opted this mission. We are working in medical and educational apostolate. The young



girls in Africa were attracted by our way of life and joined with us. Now we have seven candidates with much vigour and enthusiasm. Following the example of our Father Founder, we try to spread our charism in and around us.

It is a challenge to spread the christian faith without fear or compromise in front of the difficulties encountered. We work hard to give them a true image of the church and real liberation of the human person.

VISION FOR A BETTER “TOMORROW”

When our Father Founder started the school for the Deaf and Blind at Neerpara in the year 1968, he had the great vision that these children in no way should be left aside, but should be given every possible opportunities to overcome their disabilities and excell in their lives.

Tremendous effort has been put in by the management and staff of this school for the past 52 years to fulfil the vision and dreams of our Beloved Founder. In loving memory of this Servant of God Msgr. Joseph Kandathil this year we have constructed a swimming pool with ultramodern facilities and have started a swimming acadamy with the vision of training the deaf children in various survival and safety measures. We hope that in a state like Kerala which is at high risk of frequent floods and natural calamities, these training will help these children to save their own lives as well as of others who are in need.



“CARE OF HAND AND FOOT”

We have created simple service packages based on the needs of the lepers at Raichur. Every Saturday the Assisi NGO staff visit the leprosy colony and protect the wounds from further harm. Necessary treatment brings the lepers to comfort and enable them to live a better life. We take classes on health and hygiene to understand and solve their mental problems. Our frequent visits, care and concern help them to come out of their mental worries. We also extend our helping hands to patients with ulcer complications and reactions by admitting them in our hospital free of cost.



AWARENESS PROGRAMME AT THALAVADY

Our sisters in Thalavady belonging to Mary Matha region Tamil Nadu conducted a programme of Community Empowerment. It is an initiative by our sisters to increase knowledge and share information for upgrading health and Hygiene among the people of the locality.



PAIN AND PALLIATIVE CARE AT MANVETOM

An approach by sisters at Manvettom improves the quality of life of patients in the locality, and their family facing the problem associated with life threatening illness. By bringing the bed ridden patients to the hospital and giving them proper care and treatment, we try to reduce their pain and prepare them for a peaceful death.



VISION - MISSION - PASSION

A two days power conference was conducted for the junior sisters by Rev. Fr. Roby Kannanchira CMI, from 7 - 8 March 2020 at our Provincialate. 57 sisters attended the seminar, and all the young minds were enlightened with new insights and ideas. These two days went on well with group discussions, brain storming, group dynamics, presentations etc... under the guidance of Fr. Roby. The seminar helped the participants to come out with new plannings and findings for the better future of the province and its apostolate.
